Preamble

The Kalyan Singh Super-Specialty Cancer Institute is an autonomous Institute of the Government of Uttar Pradesh. It is envisioned as a state-of-the-art cancer treatment facility, and is slated to offer a complete range of clinical services for cancer patients, including end-of-life care, under one roof. It will also train doctors in various broad specialties and super-specialties; offer senior resident and post-doctoral certificate / fellowship positions; train nurses and paramedical staff; and focus on innovation and research aimed at providing cost-effective and value-based strategies for the diagnosis and management of cancer patients.

We are looking for faculty members, who besides being skilled in their respective disciplines, have a reasonable appreciation of data management and statistical inference techniques; can leverage information technology tools in their daily work; are team players; and demonstrate reasonable bi-lingual (English and Hindi) communication skills and empathy. The positions will be full time and private practice of every kind is prohibited.

The Institute is committed towards making medical care safe and in improving the most important goals of a person afflicted with cancer - of living longer and better. The treatment decisions would thus be necessarily made through multidisciplinary disease management groups or interest groups, functioning in virtual or real time, and not by individual consultants. This will be accompanied by periodic and systematic audits. These audits shall be the cornerstone of patient care activities at the Institution and will guide changes in various processes to make clinical care more effective, safe and convenient to patients. These will also be a critical parameter for employee / trainee appraisals.

The institution will encourage the faculty to engage and collaborate with civil society, other educational institutions and universities, philanthropic groups, and not-for-profit-organizations, for promoting the cause of evidence-based, comprehensive patient care with a societal perspective and relevant research.

Detailed Essential Qualification & Experience are as under:

- I. A medical qualification included in the first or second schedule or part II of the third schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Persons possessing qualifications included in part II of the third schedule of the said Act shall also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of the section 13 of the said Act and National Medical Commission Act, 2019. Candidate must be registered in a State Medical Register and National Medical Register except in the case of teachers with non-medical qualifications.
- II. A postgraduate qualification recognized by the Board of Governors in supersession of National Medical Commission New Delhi or equivalent thereto (i.e. if a person with postgraduate medical qualifications awarded in the United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia or New Zealand desires to take up a teaching appointment, his/her qualification can be considered as equivalent qualification with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch. as the case may be, for the post in the respective departments in medical colleges in India), as indicated in the table below for each post, is required.

United Kingdom: The candidate should have completed certificate of completion of specialist training (CCST) or equivalent training with final FRCS/FRCP degree and register in that country to practice that specialty.

United States of America and Canada: The candidate should have MD qualifications with residency training certificate in the relevant specialty in USA. For super-specialties, successful completion of residency training programme alongwith completion of accredited fellowship programme in the relevant super specialty in essential.

Australia and New Zealand: The candidate should have completed supervised training program culminating in the fellowship of the respective specialty (FRACS/FRACP). For super-specialties, minimum 02 years of supervised sub-specialty fellowship programme in the respective sub specialty is essential.

Diplomate National Board (DNB) /Doctorate of National Board (DrNB) shall be treated as equivalent to MD, MS / DM, MCh qualifications of the respective broad/super-specialties as per NMC Notification issued from time to time #.

For Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB/DrNB with MD/MS and DM/MCh.

The Diplomate of National Board (DNB/DrNB) in broad specialty and in super specialty qualification when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of five hundred or more beds by the National Board of Examinations shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super specialty (DM/MCh) postgraduate qualification. For the purposes of equivalence in teaching, persons holding a Diplomate of National Board qualification in broad specialty obtained from medical institutions with a bed strength of less than 500 shall be required to complete an additional one-year senior residency in a recognized medical institution in the relevant specialty. Certificate from concerned Hospital where DNB has been done should be provided by the candidate.

Post DNB/MD/MS a 3 years DrNB course and in case of direct entry after MBBS a 6 year DrNB Programme has to be completed from a recognized institute/medical college from NBEMS. The candidate should be registered for DrNB training in respective course and also should have passed the final exit examination leading to the award of DNB/DrNB qualification. Certificate from the recognized commission should be provided by the candidate.

- III(a). A total of 03 years of teaching and/or research experience at a NMC (erstwhile MCI) recognized teaching institution, after the prescribed MS/MD/PhD degree for the posts of Assistant Professor; or

DM/M.Ch. (03years duration) in the concerned specialty.

In subjects where, for both, broad specialties (MD/DNB) and super-specialties (DM/M.Ch.) qualification is not yet mandated by NMC, special training for 3 years in the respective/concerned specialty in a teaching Institution/Centre of Excellence in a dedicated service recognized by NMC for the purpose will be accepted. Desired research experience as per NMC is applicable.

- III(b). Additional requirements are as follows:

Assistant Professor:

For Super specialty departments the candidates must have completed the Basic Course in Biomedical Research (BCBR) from a recognized medical institution designated by the Commission.

- IV. Essential qualification and experience must be completed by the last date of filling & submission of the online application form.
- V. Essential academic qualification for various faculty positions are tabulated in Table-II.

- VI. In addition to all above, the candidate should also fulfill the minimum qualifications for teachers in medical institutions regulations as laid down by the National Medical Commission.

VII. Pay & Pay Scales:

7th pay commission as per U.P state Govt.

- **Assistant Professor:** The pay matrix Level-12 with rationalized entry pay of ₹79,800/- as per 7th pay scale (Pre-revised PB-3, & ₹15600-39100/- + AGP of ₹8000/- as per 6th pay scale) + non-practicing allowance only for medically-qualified persons) and other usual allowances, as admissible from time to time as per Uttar Pradesh State Government norms.

In addition, applicable non-practicing allowance (to clinically-qualified candidates) and other allowances as per the Institute rules will be paid. New pension scheme (NPS) of the government will be applicable.

Preference will be given to those candidates who have oncology experience of working in a reputed Institute. The clinical work will be limited to Oncology only.

VIII. Age Limit: -

- Assistant Professor: - Not exceeding 50 (Fifty) years as on the last date of the submission of the online application form or as per Govt. rules in this regard from time to time.
 - a. Upper age limit shall be determined as on last date of submission of online application form.
 - b. Age relaxation permissible to various categories is as under: -

- The age limit may be relaxable for exceptionally qualified candidates at the discretion of the selection committee, within the upper limit as prescribed by NMC.
- Government servants and candidates belonging to scheduled castes /scheduled tribes/ other backward class will get age relaxation as per Uttar Pradesh Govt. rules /orders.
- Age relaxation to other categories will also be applicable as per the DoPT instructions.
- In case of women candidates, the Caste Certificate of a person is to be decided on the basis of her birth in the said community as per UP government rules.
- Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Class, Dependents of Freedom Fighter, and Persons with Disability, Ex-Serviceman and women candidates who are not the permanent residents of Uttar Pradesh shall not be given the benefit of reservation/age relaxation. Such candidates shall be treated as the candidates of the General Category and should apply in General Category.

IX. General conditions:

- Applicants may also be considered for appointment on contractual basis or on deputation.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be rejected. Incomplete application includes:
 - Non-deposition of requisite fee
 - Non-availability of caste certificate when applicable
 - In case of women candidates, the caste certificate issued from father's side only will be treated valid.
 - UP Domicile certificate from relevant authorities.
 - Non-submission of Certificates on support of experience
 - Non-submission of Certificate of registration of medical qualifications by NMC when applicable
 - Not meeting the desired publications with indexing and authorship
- Those in service must append a 'no-objection certificate' from the current employer or the same must be submitted before or on the day of interview.
- In case of non-availability of candidates with requisite qualifications and experience, the selection committee may make such recommendations as it may deem fit subject to the provisions laid down by the NMC.
- The number of posts indicated above is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- Selections & Interview may not be held for all the advertised posts.

- A **Non-refundable** application fee of **Rs. 1000** for OBC/SC/ST domiciled in the state of Uttar Pradesh, needs to be paid online before the application form can be filled.
- The candidate must ensure that correct and complete information is filled, as it will be used to determine suitability for appearing in the interview. **The Institute will not be responsible if the application of any candidate is rejected on the basis of incomplete or faulty information filled online. Forms with incomplete information will be rejected.**
- Emails and contact details including correct postal address and telephone numbers currently used of 3 referees must be mentioned in your application form.
- **Documentary proof of experience with duration claimed is a must.**

- The horizontal reservation in respect of teaching posts will be decided as per existing provisions.
- Candidates will be intimated by email regarding the date of interview and the information regarding date of interview will also be projected on the Institute website. No TA / DA will be paid to attend the interview.
- Mere eligibility does not entitle a candidate to be called for an interview or to claim for appointment.
- Only shortlisted candidates will be called for a personal Interview. Interviews via video-call may be permitted on request, subject to the candidate accepting inherent risks of technology failure.
- The appointment shall be subject to certification of medical fitness by the Medical Board of Institute / authorized medical board.
- After on-line submission, a print out of the application and attachments needs to be sent by speed post / registered post / courier only. This must contain: copies of proofs of educational/academic qualifications, experience, testimonials, research publications, no-objection certificate from current employer and latest caste certificate etc. as indicated therein. In the case of difficulty in uploading annexures online, these necessarily need to be enclosed along with the print copy and a covering letter indicating this fact. It is mandatory to self- attest copies of all the certificates along with the submitted application form.
