District Health & Family Welfare Samiti, Jhargram will engage personnel for the positions as stated below under National AYUSH Mission (NAM), Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal purely on contractual basis.

Selection Procedure:

Applications will be short listed on the basis of marks obtained in educational qualification and experience and merit list will be prepared. From this merit list, candidates will be called for computer test where computer test is mandatory. Candidates will be selected from merit list according to vacancy. Where (For MPW post) the computer test is mandatory, the applicants will have to obtain at least 50% marks; falling which the candidature will be treated as cancelled. Final selection will be done on the basis of Marks obtained on Merit, computer test (where applicable) and experience.

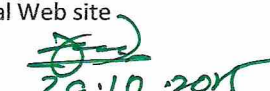
