- 1. It is candidates' responsibility to ascertain and ensure their eligibility as per the prescribed qualification and experience. The performance of the selected candidates will be reviewed every 3 months. Any unauthorised absence from duties for 3 or more working days shall lead to termination of contract.
- 3. Expiry of Contract: The contract will automatically expire after 11 months from date of selection. The contractual appointment can be terminated at any time by either side by giving 30 days' notice or salary in lieu thereof.
- 4. As the project work involves data collection at the site of forest area near to NCL mining zone Jayant area of Distt. Singrauli, MP; the project staff selected will be posted there for data collection anytime/all time during their tenure of work.
