Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidate should be an Indian national.
- Candidate shall pass regular and full time Degree/Diploma/ITI/10th in relevant trades from Govt. recognised institutions/Boards/Universities.
- Candidates who have undergone /undergoing or already registered in the same apprenticeship under NATS/NAPS elsewhere are not eligible.
- Candidates with work experience of one or more years are not eligible.
- Candidate should possess Diploma/Graduation from a recognized University on or after the year 2021.
- Candidates who have completed their required qualification from the institutes situated in Odisha State are only eligible to apply.
- For ITI apprenticeship, maximum upper age limit for candidates under General category is 23 years as on 13.08.2025. Upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST category, by 3 years for OBC (Non creamy layer) category, 10 years for PwBD category as per Govt. guidelines.

General Instructions:

- i. The aspiring candidates shall register/enrol as “Candidate” in the respective apprenticeship portals like NATS 2.0 for Graduate/Diploma Candidates and NAPS for ITI candidates.
- ii. Stipend will be paid as per Apprentices Act as amended from time to time.
- iii. After completion of Apprenticeship Training, the Apprenticeship contract will be terminated and there will be no obligation on the part of HAL to offer any employment.
- iv. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates who are attending the walk-in.
- v. Presently, a working lunch is being provided to the apprentices on courtesy basis on working days.
- vi. Hostel will be provided subjected to availability during training period.
- vii. The candidates shall report to the venue with the following original documents (as applicable) and one set self-attested photo copy and one recent passport size colour photograph.
 - a. 10th/SSC/SSLC mark sheet
 - b. ITI/Diploma/Graduation pass certificate/ provisional certificate
 - c. ITI/Diploma/Graduation pass marks sheet of all semesters/years and consolidated mark sheet/divisional mark sheet.
 - d. In case of marks are in GPS/CGPA, University guidelines for converting GPA/CGPA to Percentage is required.
 - e. Reserved category applicant must produce EWS/Caste/PwBD Certificate issued by the competent authority.
 - f. Details of registration/enrolment of the candidate in NAPS/NATS 2.0 portal.
 - g. Aadhar card.
 - h. Institution/College Leaving Certificate or Transfer Certificate.

Selection:

- i. For ITI Candidates- Selection is based on the marks scored by the candidates in qualifying examinations.70% weightage of 10th grade and 30% weightage of ITI marks will be taken into consideration.
- ii. For Graduate and Diploma Candidates- Selection is based on the marks scored by the candidates in qualifying examinations.
- iii. Reservation will be applied as per Apprenticeship Act/Govt./Company guide lines.
- iv. Shortlisted candidates will be called through email for document verification and joining.
- v. Canvassing in any form will result in disqualification.
