- 1. All the educational qualifications/certificates shall be from the recognized Board/University.
- 2. All the experience gained shall be preferably from the Govt. Organizations and shall be counted after the date of completion of Minimum Essential Qualification. Experience from reputed national/international organizations will also be considered.
- 3. Experience shall be from the relevant field/area, as required for the study of the Project concerned.
- 4. All community certificates should be issued by the authorized officers of the Govt.
- 5. The required relevant Field/Specialization may be mentioned in bracket against the position that is to be filled.
- 6. **Job Description:** To provide assistance in conducting the project in the form of microplanning and data collection, quality assurance & supervision, qualitative interviews, training of field workers, procurement and maintenance of tools & equipment, meeting and liaising with government officials, financial record-keeping and other tasks assigned by PI
- 7. The employee would need to have a valid driver's license for a two-wheeler (with gear) & car and own/arrange for a two-wheeler/car for travel related to the project.

- a. Interested candidates may download the application form from the AIIMS Bhopal website. The duly filled applications along with CV and other relevant supportive documents should be submitted at the time of walk in interview between 9am to 10am in single PDF file only in person on scheduled date and venue.
- b. Incomplete applications or the applications without prescribed format or received after the prescribed date and timings will not be considered.
- c. Candidates kindly ensure their eligibility for the given post.
- d. The date of walk in interview would be used as the cut-off for calculation of age to be considered essential for eligibility of the candidate.
- e. Date of Walk In Interview/Exam/Skill test will be held on 25th Aug. 2025
- f. The following documents are required at the time of Walk in Interview:
 - i. Duly filled application form
 - ii. Self-attested photocopies of proof of date of birth (birth certificate/ class 10th certificate), eligibility qualification mark-sheets, degrees, experience certificate, caste certificate (if applicable), qualifying degree registration with statutory council (if applicable) and other relevant testimonials.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility and Qualifications:

It is the candidates' responsibility to ascertain and ensure their eligibility as per the prescribed qualifications and experience. Any misinformation detected at any stage will make the candidate liable for legal action. Permission to appear in the selection process does not approve the eligibility of the candidate. Even after qualifying for the selection process, the candidate may be rendered disqualified at the time of document verification if he/she doesn't fulfil essential eligibility criteria.

2. Contractual Nature of the Position:

2.1. Appointments are on a purely contract basis for an externally funded project, with no claim to regular posts at AIIMS Bhopal or Funding Agency. The duration is project-specific, and employment may be extended or terminated at the discretion of the Project Investigator. The core posts will be governed as per the rules / instructions received from the ICMR competent authority from time to time. This appointment will not vest any right to claim by the candidate for regular appointment or permanent absorption in AIIMS Bhopal or ICMR or for continued contractual appointment

2.2. The contract automatically expires at the end of the specified period unless mutually renewed. Either party can terminate the contract with 30 days' notice or salary in lieu thereof.

3. Remuneration and Leave:

3.1. The leave entitlement of the appointee shall be governed in terms of the ICMR leave policy governing extramural research projects as amended from time to time.

4 Accommodation:

4.1. No hostel or any other accommodation will be provided by the Institute or the Principal Investigator.

5. Application and Selection Process:

- 5.1. Candidates must submit duly filled and complete applications, including their CVs and required documents as mentioned above at the time of walk in interview. Incomplete or incorrect submissions will be rejected.
- 5.2.A valid email ID and mobile number are mandatory for communication.
- 5.3. Updates regarding results will be available on the AIIMS Bhopal website, and no individual intimation will be sent.
- 5.4. No TA/DA will be provided for appearing in the test or interview. Interviews may be conducted in person or via videoconferencing.

6. Responsibilities and Conduct:

- 6.1. Candidates employed in government or other funded research projects must provide a "No Objection Certificate" from their employer.
- 6.2. Private practice is prohibited, and candidates are expected to adhere to institute rules and disciplinary conduct. Candidates may be posted at rural or field sites as per project needs.
- 6.3. The decision of the competent authority in the selection process is final. Any form of canvassing or submission of false information will lead to disqualification.
- 6.4. The prescribed qualification is minimum and mere possessing the same does not entitle any candidate for selection.
- 6.5. The candidate applying in response to his advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility in all respects.
