Desirable Qualifications for all teaching posts- (Due weightage to be given during selection)

- (i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

Other Requirement Applicable to All the Above Posts

1. Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
2. Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
3. Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
4. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Selection Procedure

5. **Scrutiny of Application.** Upon receiving the application, the screening committee will scrutinize all applications on the basis of eligibility criteria. All qualified candidates will be intimated accordingly via school email for written test.

The first part of selection process is written test. This test is not required for candidates who have taught in other AF schools for a minimum period of two years in the same category. **Written test for all other candidates is scheduled on 03 Mar 2026.** The details of written test (for sl no 1 to 9) as follows:

7. **Teaching Aptitude Test (TAT).** Second part of selection process (for sl no. 01 to 09). All candidates who have passed the Written Test will be called for a Teaching Aptitude Test of 130 marks. This also includes the candidates who have taught in other AF Schools in the same category of post they have applied. This will include demonstration class of 40 minutes with the specified topics provided through school email. TAT is scheduled from **10 Mar 2026** tentatively. Final date will be sent via school email along with topic post selection in written test. Candidates will have to secure a minimum of 80 marks out of 130, to be eligible for the interview. A practical test for ability to use technology will also be conducted as part of TAT. Test would be of 20 marks and candidate will have to secure minimum 10 marks. Candidate is required to pass both TAT and practical test for ability to use technology separately.

8. **Interview.** Candidates who have qualified the Teaching Aptitude Test will be called for an interview of 100 marks, which will be the final stage of the selection process. The Selection Committee will focus on communication ability and the co-curricular skills of the candidates besides assessing the subject knowledge. Date of interview will be informed via school email to qualified TAT candidates.

9. Date of written test/ interview/ demonstration/ skill test will be separately intimated to the shortlisted candidates only, through school email. Candidates applying for any post/s, have to come for written test/ aptitude test/ interview on their own. No TA/DA whatsoever will be paid for attending the written test/ aptitude test/ interview. **Separate applications are to be sent if applying for more than one post.**

10. **Procedure for applying:** Interested candidates can apply in **prescribed format only (available on school website)** alongwith copies of all necessary documents/ testimonials. Last date for receiving application (in prescribed format alongwith, copies of relevant documents) will be **14 Feb 2026**.
