4. Reservations:

Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS category, as per Presidential directives, will be provided as indicated in the "Details of the Posts". Reservation for Persons with Benchmark disabilities (PWBD) and Ex-Servicemen (ESM) shall be on Horizontal basis as per prevailing rules. PWBDs belonging to categories of disability mentioned above and having disability of 40% or more only shall be considered. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates of the disability category for which the vacancy is reserved, the same will be filled by interchange from among other suitable disability category.

OBC candidates who belong to "CREAMY LAYER" are not entitled for OBC concession and such candidates have to indicate their category as "General". OBC (non-creamy layer) candidates are required to submit requisite certificate in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority issued in the current financial year (2024-25).

Caste Certificates should be submitted in the prescribed format for appointment to posts under Government of India/ Central Government/ Public Sector Undertaking (format available in our website www.sail.co.in at careers link) issued by the Competent Authority as given in the formats and not below the rank of Tehsildar. The OBC reservation is applicable to only those candidates who belong to Non-Creamy Layer and fall under central government list for the respective State. The non-creamy layer status should be valid on the closing date of receipt of application.

For claiming the benefit admissible to PwbDs under the Act, candidates are required to produce disability certificate (as per format available in our website www.sail.co.in) issued by the Competent authority as per the provisions of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016. They have to satisfy the relaxed Physical Standard required for the posts. In case, the candidate fails to produce the certificate in the prescribed format issued by Competent Authority, his/her candidature will not be considered. A copy of the Disability Certificate must be submitted at the time of interview/skill test/trade test for consideration of their name under PwD category.

5. Selection Procedure:

AM (Safety)(E1)	The mode of selection for eligible applicant would be through written test/online test(CBT) followed by an interview of qualifying candidates in written test/online test (CBT), called in the ration of 1:3 in order of merit. However, if for any position, the ratio of applicants for the post is less than 1:5, only interview will be conducted. If the cut off marks of CBT, so arrived at, are obtained by more than one candidate –all of them will be called for interview. For final selection, merit list will be drawn by combining the scores of online test (CBT) and the interview with the weightage of 80:20 in that order or as per the merit list of the interview (as the case may be). Information regarding written test/online test (CBT)/Interview will be provided in the admit card/call letter/which will be uploaded on careers page of SAIL website and candidates will be intimated for the same through their emails. No other communication will be sent to the candidates for the purpose. Online test (CBT): Provisionally eligible candidates will be required to appear for objective type Written test/online test (CBT) consisting of 100 multiple choice questions at the centre decide by the management. The minimum qualifying marks in the online test for unreserved candidates will be determined based on 50 percentile score.

No other communication will be sent to the candidates for the purpose. Weightage of marks of Online test (CBT) will be 100%. Trade/skill test will only be of qualifying nature. Online test (CBT): Provisionally eligible candidates will be required to appear for objective type online test (CBT) consisting of 100 multiple choice questions at the centre decide by the management. The minimum qualifying marks in the online test for unreserved candidates will be determined based on 50 percentile score. For SC/OBC/PWD candidates, the qualifying marks will be 40 percentile score.

6. Training & Probation:

Candidates selected for the post of AM (Safety) and Jr Engineering Associate (Boiler Operation) shall be on probation for one year and confirmation shall be based on proper assessment of conduct and performance.

12. Mode of payment of fee:

Candidates will be required to pay application fee through net banking /credit card/debit card, after filling the required details in the online application form at www.sail.co.in. Fee shall not be collected by any other mode. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

13. How to apply:

While submitting the application online, candidate should note the following:

- Before applying the candidates should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility norms. SAIL/SSP will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for eligibility and other aspects at the time of the Online test (CBT), and therefore the candidature is accepted provisionally.
- All certificates and documents in support of eligibility will be verified only during the interview/trade/skill test and any candidate, who fails to produce the same, will not be allowed to appear for interview/trade/skill test and their candidature for the post will be cancelled forthwith. Therefore, candidates are requested to ensure their eligibility before applying
- Candidates must write his/her name as it appears in the matriculation certificate or equivalent examination. In case of change of name at a later stage, necessary documentary proof to be submitted at the time of skill test/trade test.

- Candidate should have latest passport size coloured photograph(.jpg or .jpeg file only upto 50kb) as well as photograph of own signature in digital format(.jpg or .jpeg file only upto 20 kb) for uploading with the application form

- Category (GEN/SC/ST/OBC/PWBD/ESM/EWS) once submitted in the online application cannot be changed and no benefit of other category will be subsequently admissible.

- Wherever CGPA/OGPA or letter grade in a diploma / degree is awarded; equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the online application form as per norms adopted by the University / Institute. Where no norms have been specified, the CGPA / OGPA will be presumed to have been provided on a 10 point scale. The candidates will have to produce a copy of these norms with respect to their University / Institute at the time of interview/skill test/trade test.
- Shortlisted Candidates appearing in the interview /skill test/trade test shall be required to furnish

 PWBD status, registration slip, e-receipt of application fee etc. at the time of skill test/trade test as per
 intimation given to the shortlisted candidates.
